




Tayside Orienteers Christmas Score

Final details



Parking. Corsiehill quarry car park at grid 135235 or W3W plot.bake.files quarry, see map. If the high vehicle gate is closed and you have a van there is room to park on the road outside the quarry.



Timings:

- Registration open for the collection of hired dibbers from 10:15
- Briefing for all competitors at 10:50
- 60 minute course mass start at 11:00. 45 minute course mass start at 11:05

Terrain. Using the east side of Kinnoull Hill and the west part of Deuchny woods, the map recently revised for the Scottish Middle Distance race. The 45 minute score has plenty of TD 3 controls

Courses.

- 60 minutes. 1:10,000 map. 19 controls. About 9km and 300m climb gets them all.
- 45 minutes. 1:7500 map. 17 controls. About 7km and 200m to get them all.
- Both courses have some controls not on the map with generous extra points. Clues at the briefing.


Start. This will be a quick punching start to accommodate any novices who might need a few minutes of advice.

Courses Closed. All courses close at 12:15. We know that some competitors use a score event to get all the controls, irrespective of the penalties. Please don't. We would like you in as close as possible to 45 or 60 minutes so that controls can be collected and we can get to lunch.

Facilities. There will not be toilets at the event.

Safety. Whistles are compulsory. Cagoules may be required if it is scheduled to be very wet / cold. There is one road crossing, minor road, this will be marshalled. The Christmas Tree seller will be in the forestry hut so take care round cars using that carpark.

Signage. This event will be deliberately 'light' on organisation so that we can get the event packed up, controls in and off to lunch quickly. As a result, there will not be much signage. Please see sketches for the layout to get you to the start and from finish back to download.
